

Adjudication Requirements

One solo piece, memorization is encouraged. Provide your own accompanist and a score for adjudicators. Photocopied music is not allowed.

The participants on the six instruments (violin, viola, cello, bass, classical guitar, and harp) will be judged in the following categories:

- Junior Elementary (up to 3rd grade)
- Senior Elementary (4th - 6th)
- Junior (7th - 9th)
- Senior (10th - 12th)
- College (Fresh. Soph. Jr. Sr.)

The level guidelines are according to the ASTA with NSOA String Syllabus, revised in 1997 or 2003.

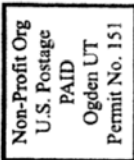
